The Executive Board

1. Takes note of the analysis of gaps undertaken to test, in DRC, the approach adopted through [Decision EB. 2016.10](#) and recognizes that such gaps, if not addressed, will prevent the demonstration of CAFI impacts in the region
2. Requests the FONAREDD Technical Secretariat to work with the CAFI Secretariat to address these gaps in approved programmes, to prevent them in future programmes and to present to the next EB meeting (end June 2017) how these have been addressed
3. Requests implementing agencies who are observers to the CAFI EB to engage in discussions with CAFI Secretariat when, upon developing programmes, they face difficulties in choosing from the menu of CAFI indicators
4. Agrees that the four CAFI governance indicators should be monitored in all CAFI partner countries, and requests implementing agencies to contribute to the methodology to collect data and provide information to the CAFI Secretariat, so that a baseline is established in 2016 for each CAFI partner country
